CALL FOR PAPERS

In order to be able to submit papers to the journal and check the current status of your submissions, you must be logged in as a registered user.

The collection of scientific papers “Aesthetics and Ethics of Pedagogical Action” accepts scientific articles that have not been previously published in scientific journals and correspond to the subject of the publication, reviews or overviews of new scientific and pedagogical literature; notifications and reports on scientific events (conferences, congresses, symposia, etc.).

Papers are submitted in electronic form to the editorial office’s e-mail: lobacholena58@gmail.com

The article is 10-12 pages in length.

The text of the paper should be typed and edited in Word, without hyphenation, saved in doc or rtf format, Times New Roman font, 14 point, line spacing – one and a half, indentation – 1.25 cm, alignment – width, all margins – 2 cm, word spacing – 1 space.

Create tables and charts in Word or Excel. Graphic elements should be grouped. The color of text and graphs is black and white.

Captions for figures and tables should be typed in 12-point Times New Roman font. Figures and tables are placed in the text of the paper with alignment in the center of the page, without flowing around the text within the typing field. Figures and tables are presented in the paper after the text where they are mentioned for the first time. Each formula, table, figure, and graph in the text must be referenced.

Quotation marks – «». If there is a quotation within a quotation or a quotation contains a word in quotation marks, then the outer quotation marks – «», and the internal – “”.

Use non-breaking spaces between initials, initials and surname, a word and the following dash, in dates, the last word and title, and the page and its digital designation (p. 22).

Requirements for the preparation of paper abstracts in Ukrainian:

- abstract in Ukrainian – up to 10 lines of text, 5-7 keywords;
- extended abstract in English – 2/3 of the text page (1800 characters), 5-7 keywords (the text of the English-language abstract in Ukrainian must be attached to the article for verification by a literary editor of foreign texts).

Requirements for the preparation of paper abstracts in foreign languages:

- abstract in the original language – up to 10 lines of text, 5-7 keywords;
- a non-English-language paper is accompanied by two identical abstracts in English and Ukrainian – 2/3 of a page of text (1800 characters), 5-7 keywords;
- an English-language paper is accompanied by an extended abstract in Ukrainian – 2/3 of a page of text (1800 characters), 5-7 keywords.

Structure of the paper:

- 1. Problem statement.**
- 2. Analysis of recent research and publications.**
- 3. The purpose of the paper.**

4. Methods of research.

5. Presentation of the main material.

6. Conclusions.

7. Prospects for further research (Excerpt from the Resolution of the Presidium of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine dated January 15, 2003, No. 7-05/1).

References in the paper and the list of references should be drawn up in accordance with the requirements of the American Psychological Association Style (samples are attached).

The list of references is given at the end of the paper in the original language (Russian sources are excluded): first, Ukrainian-language sources are listed in alphabetical order; then foreign sources are listed alphabetically. Sources are not numbered; each source begins with an overhanging paragraph - 1.25.

The English-language abstract is followed by the subtitle **“References”** and a list of references transliterated into Latin, which is formatted as follows:

- the entire list of references is transliterated while maintaining the APA style; it is recommended to use online services to automate the transliteration process. For the transliteration of Ukrainian text into Latin, the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated January 27, 2010, No. 55 (<http://translit.kh.ua/#passport>) should be used; for other languages, regional services are used. English-language sources are not transliterated.
- titles of papers, conferences, journals, books, etc. are translated into *English* and indicated in square brackets.

The paper is accompanied by

- information about the author: surname, name, patronymic, academic degree, academic title, place of work, position, phone (office/mobile), e-mail;
- papers submitted by master’s students, postgraduate students, and applicants (persons without a degree) must be accompanied by a review signed by a doctor or candidate of science, or a supervisor (the reviewer’s signature is certified by a seal in the personnel department).

Requirements for the submission of abstracts

- Abstracts must be submitted in electronic format (Microsoft Word);
- Length: 3–5 pages of printed text, without page numbers;
- A4 format;
- Line spacing: 1.5;
- Paragraph indentation: 1.25 cm;
- Margins: right, left, bottom, top – 2.0 cm;
- Punctuation: quotation marks («»), apostrophe (’), hyphen not separated by spaces (-), long dash (–);

• ***The authors of the publications are responsible for the accuracy of facts, quotations, names, titles and other information. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject papers and abstracts that do not meet the above requirements, do not fit the collection’s theme, or lack scientific novelty;***

• ***Abstracts for the collection are submitted after their uniqueness has been verified and academic plagiarism has been identified.*** Verification is carried out using software and technical tools.

Structure and formatting of abstracts:

• Abstracts must include the following elements: a brief justification of the problem, references to key studies on the topic, a summary of the main points and conclusions, and possible avenues for further research;

• In the top left-hand corner, the UDC code must be indicated in bold, 14-point font;

• In the top right-hand corner, the author’s (authors’) surname and initials should be printed in bold, 14-point font;

• Below the surname and initials, without a line break, in regular font, 14-point size, the academic degree and position of the author(s) should be indicated;

• One line down, centered in capital letters, in bold, 14-point font, the title of the abstract is printed;

• One line down, starting a new paragraph, the abstract in Ukrainian (3–4 sentences) and keywords (4–5 words) are printed in italics, 12-point font;

• Skip a line; the main text of the article should be set in 14-point type from the start of the paragraph (references to sources used should be formatted in square brackets, with the source number and page number of the citation in that edition separated by a comma, e.g. [5, p.12]);

• The bibliography (list of references) is provided at the end of the main text in 12-point font. *The bibliography is formatted in accordance with the amendments set out in the Standard for Bibliographic References, dated July 1, 2016 (Information and Documentation. Bibliographic Reference. General Provisions and Rules for Compilation DSTU 8302-2015. http://ped.pnpu.edu.ua/standart_pocilan.pdf)*
